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Definitions

SRID: *Sleep-related infant deaths.* A unique grouping of infant deaths caused by injury or Positional Asphyxia, and Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS). In New York City, SRID accounted for over eighty percent (80%) of infant injury deaths from 2004 to 2011ⁱ. SRID is a subset of SUID.

SUID: *Sudden Unexpected Infant Deaths.* The sudden, unexpected death of an infant under one year, and which is not immediately obvious prior to any investigation (CDC).

SIDS: *Sudden Infant Death Syndrome.* The sudden death of an infant under one year which cannot be explained through autopsy, investigation of the case and death scene, and infant or family's medical history (CDC).

UHF: *United Hospital Fund Neighborhood.* 42 geographical areas defined by a group of zip codes [in NYC] (NY State DOH, NYC DOHMH).

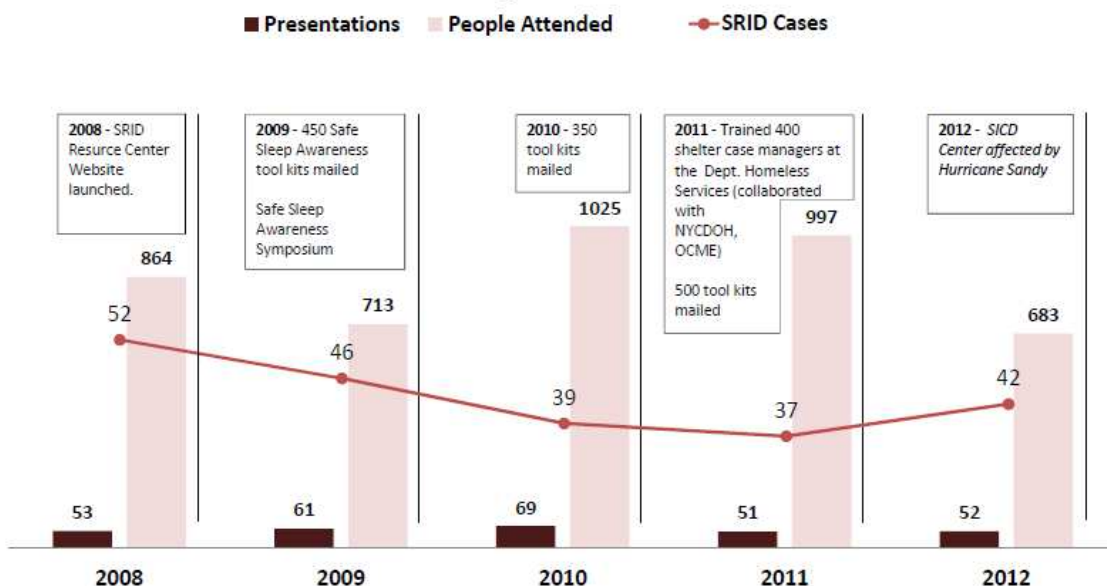

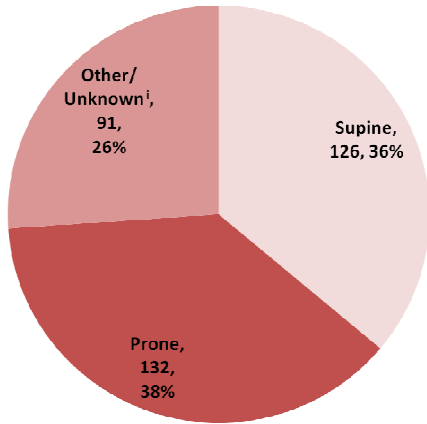

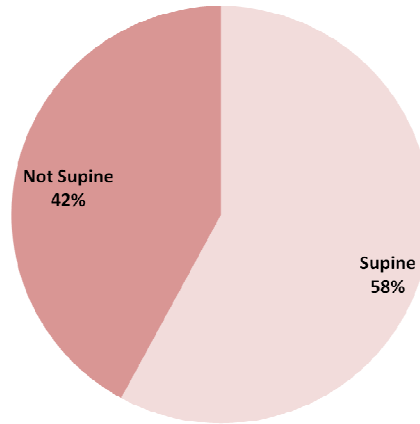

(NYC PRAMS 2004/2005 - 2010)ⁱⁱ**



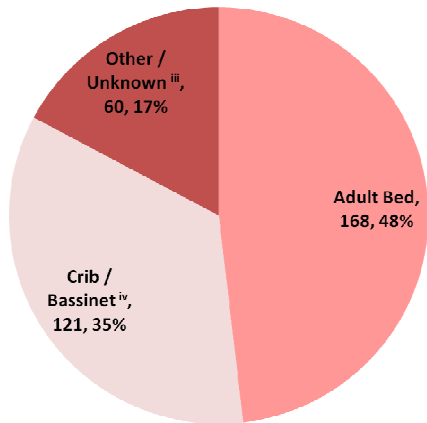

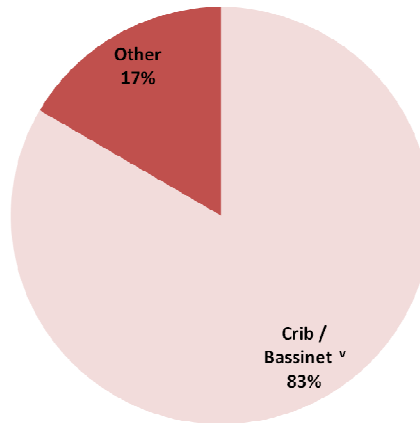

(NYC PRAMS 2004/2005 - 2010)ⁱⁱ**

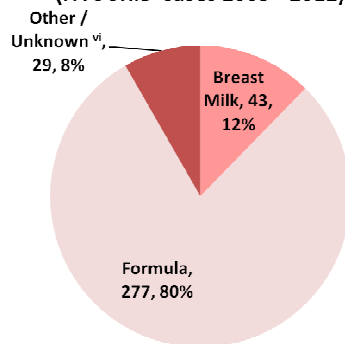

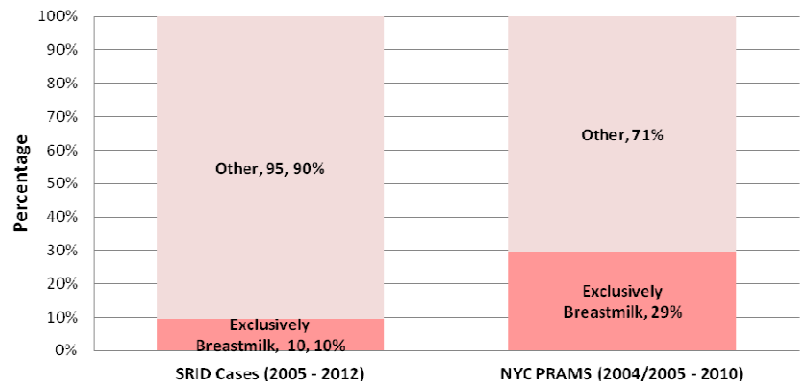

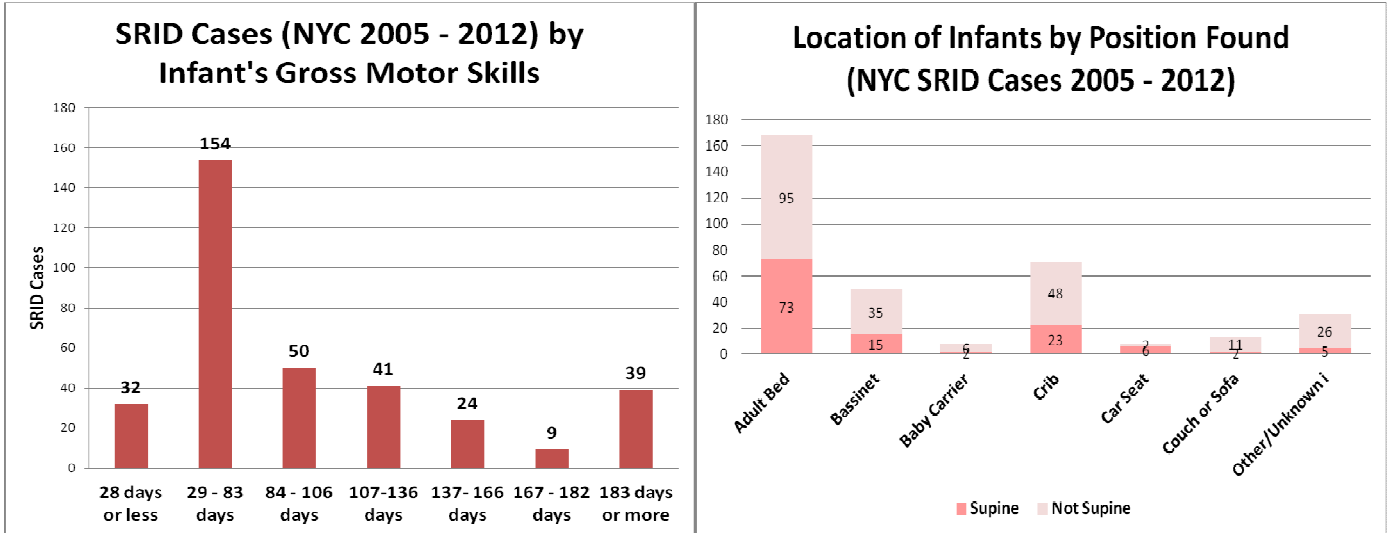

(NYC SRID Cases 2005 - 2012)**



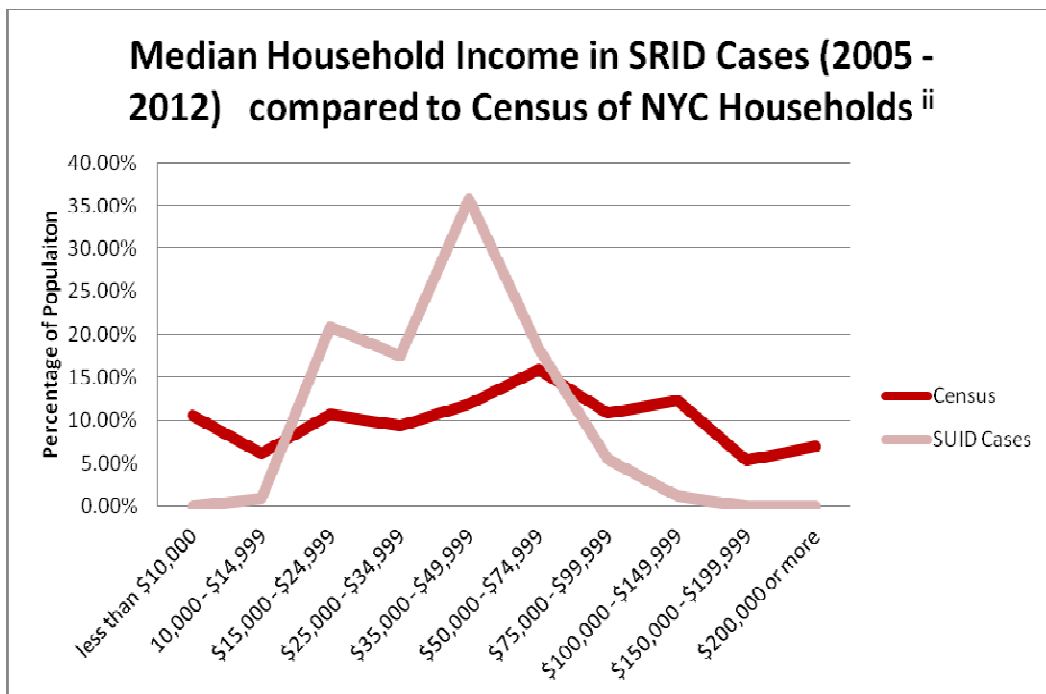

Gross Motor Skills by Age at which most (90%) infants can do skill (CDC):

- 0 - 83 days** (can lift head and chin slightly, and briefly, when lying on flat surface)
- 84 - 106 days** (can lift head 45° off surface when lying on stomach)
- 107 - 136 days** (can lift head 90° off surface when lying on stomach)
- 137 - 166 days** (can roll over from lying on stomach to back first, then from back to stomach)
- 167 - 182 days** (can raise chest and support self on outstretched arms when lying prone on stomach)
- 183 - 365 days** (can keep head level with body when pulled to sitting position when lying on back)
